Residents will need to call us to arrange a coil or implant fittings. Check the clinic webpage for details then call us to book an appointment.

 - For Earnsdale call 07801 629974 during clinic opening times
 - For Woking call 07808 895225 during clinic opening times

- **Home testing kit (for Chlamydia, Gonorrhoea, Syphilis and HIV) for over 18s**

- **Online contraception** From January 2019, new and existing patients will be able to order contraception online. A prescription is delivered and can be taken to a pharmacy.

Condoms

The Get it On Condom Distribution (C-Card) Scheme is a free and confidential condom distribution network for people aged under 25 years old in Surrey. Ask at one of our clinics or visit the healthy surrey website for a list of outlets:

Spoke Clinics

Contraception only services are provided in Epsom, Leatherhead, Stanwell and Addlestone (**Appointments only**)

- **Derby Medical Centre in Epsom** 8, the Square, Epsom KT19 8AG (Wednesdays 3pm to 7pm except on the first Wednesday of the month when it is open 5pm to 7pm)
- **Stanwell Health and Community Centre** Hadrian Way, Stanwell TW19 7HE Wednesdays (second and fourth Wednesday of the month)
- **Runnymede** Addlestone Youth Centre, 121-125 Church Road, Addlestone KT15 1SH Tuesdays (first and third Tuesday of the month)

Emergency Contraception

If you need emergency contraception you can walk into any of the following CNWL Hub Clinics:

- Buryfields Clinic, 61 Lawn Road
- Woking Clinic, Woking Hospital, Heathside Road, Woking, GU22 7HS
- Earndale Clinic, 2 Whitepost Hill, Redhill, RH1 6BD

PEP (Post Exposure Prophylaxis) for HIV

Post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) is a treatment that can reduce the risk of HIV infection after contact with the virus

If you need PEP you can walk into either of the following CNWL Hub Clinics:

- Buryfields Clinic, 61 Lawn Road, Guildford, GU2 4AX
- Earnsdale Clinic, 2 Whitepost Hill, Redhill, RH1 6BD

You can also get PEP by attending an Accident and Emergency Department

Sexual Assault

If you have been sexually assaulted you can visit a specialist centre for advice and to arrange a forensic examination.

CNWL does not offer forensic examinations but we can provide emergency contraception, PEP and sexual health screening and treatment.
